We were back at the bargaining table today and talks are ongoing with the government to reach a deal. We still have some ground to cover, and the bargaining teams are looking forward to getting back to it tomorrow as we fight for a fair contract for PSAC members.

And that means we're still on strike and we're back on the picket line in the morning. Picket locations and timing may be adjusted from day to day, so please check our [picket line finder](#) before leaving in the morning.

A historic day

We had a BIG first day on the picket lines, with PSAC members showing their solidarity at more than 260 picket lines across the country.

From jazz lines to marching bands and picket-pooches, the lines were hopping today, and you delivered the message loud and clear – we're prepared to step up and fight for decent wages and better working conditions.

How to prepare for tomorrow



Stay plugged in! We'll keep you in the loop with updates as they happen, so make sure you keep an eye out for our communications, and turn on notifications for our emails, texts, and social media posts.



Keep in touch with your coworkers. Information is power, so it's essential that you and your coworkers share important bargaining updates. Amplify our content to make a splash and send a message to the government.



Prepare to get to the picket line. When you arrive, we'll have everything you need to get started. Each location 📍 will have a picket captain to sign you in with your personalized barcode or PSAC ID and a strike captain who will answer your questions. Don't have your barcode? Don't worry. Talk to our PSAC team to check in. You don't need to RSVP to attend a picket line, but if you decide to, you'll get reminders and the latest bargaining updates.



Keep moving and have fun. We encourage you to bring your friends, colleagues, and some music.



Take lots of photos! We want to show the power of our movement, so it's important to share photos from the picket line. Post it on social media and tag PSAC so we can spread the word.
